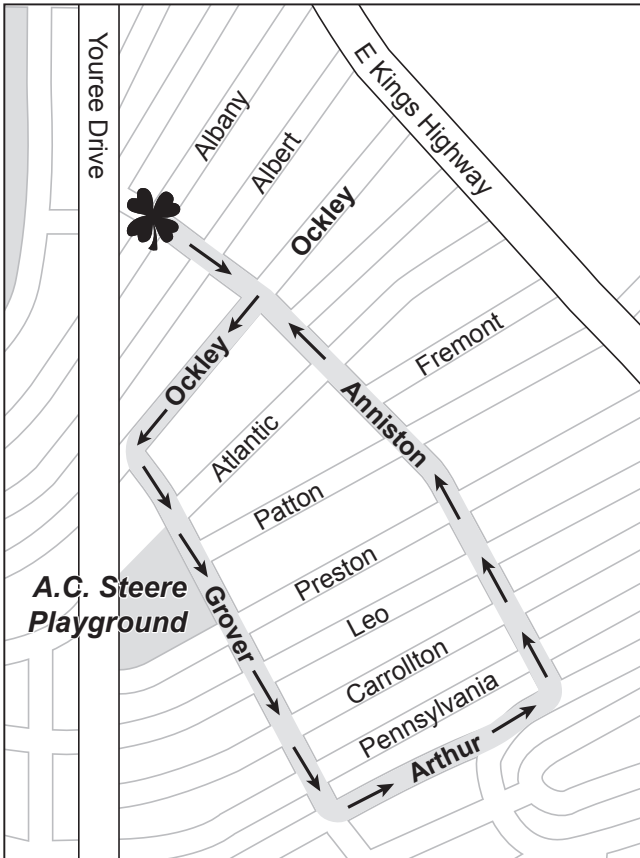




5th ANNUAL SHREVEPORT ST. PATRICK'S DAY PARADE
